

Volume of Rectangular Prisms



Right Prisms

- A right prism is a geometric solid that has a polygon as its base and vertical sides perpendicular to the base. The base and top surface are the same shape and size.
- Polygon – Many sided shape (octagon, hexagon...)

VOLUME

VOLUME is the amount of liquid or solid that will ***FILL*** a 3-Dimensional object!

**Always measured in units cubed (u^3)*

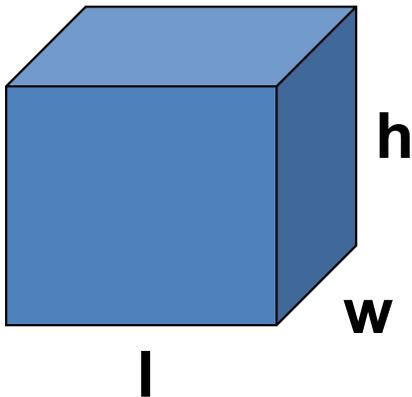
QUICK DEFINITION

- ***3-Dimensional*** objects are NOT FLAT.
- They have 3 measurements:
 - ***Length***
 - ***Width***
 - ***Height***

What Does Volume Mean?

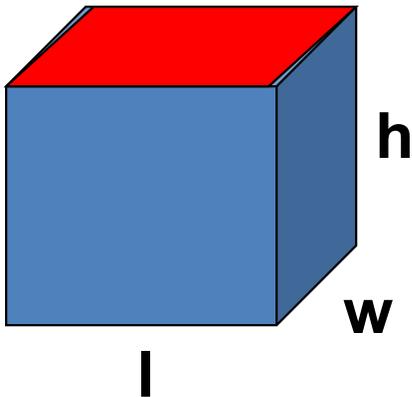

- **Volume** – the amount of space occupied by an object.



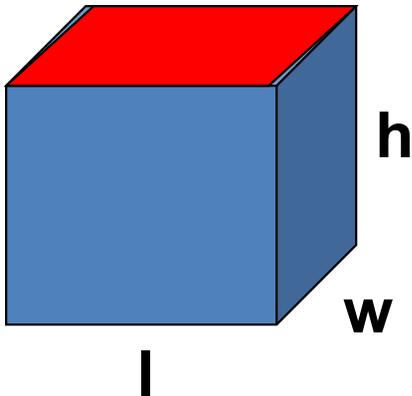
Example:
The VOLUME of this cube is all the space contained by the sides of the cube, measured in cube units (units³).

- **Volume** – To calculate the volume of a prism, we first need to calculate the area of the **BASE** of the prism.



Example: The AREA of the base of this rectangular prism is $l \times w$.

- **Volume** – Once we know the area of the base, this is then multiplied by the height to determine the **VOLUME** of the prism.



We find that:

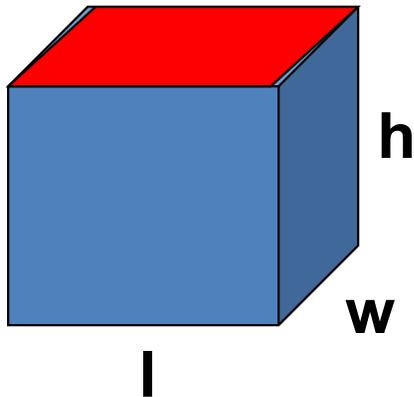
Volume = Area of Base x Height

Volume = (l x w) x h

*Pro tip: Don't just multiply all the numbers together. Find the area of the base and multiply by the height. This will make finding the volume of other prisms much easier if you learn this way.

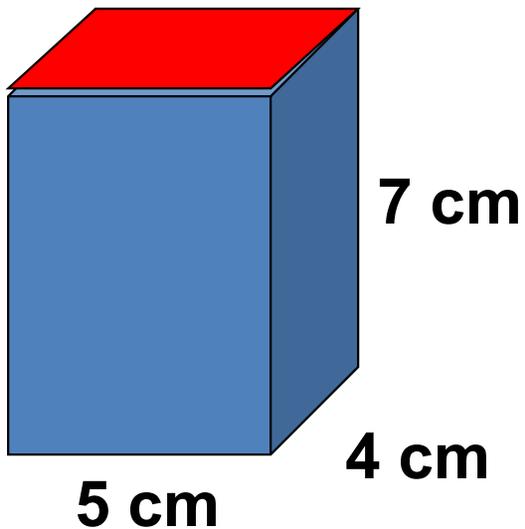
Formula:

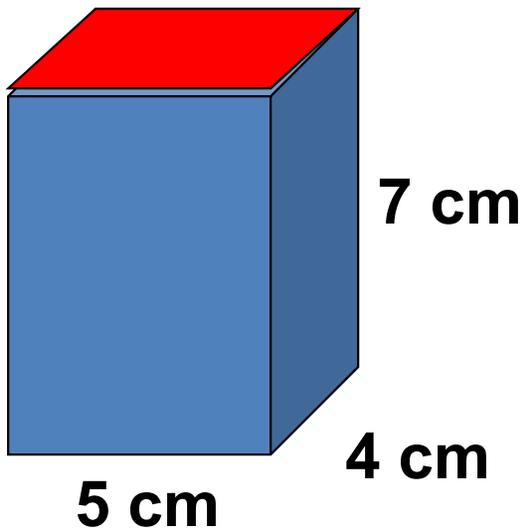

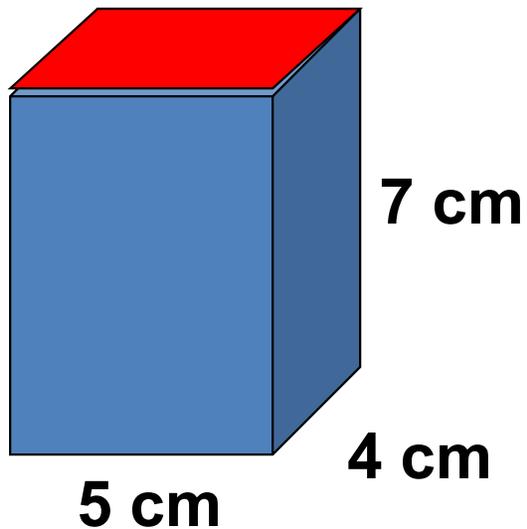

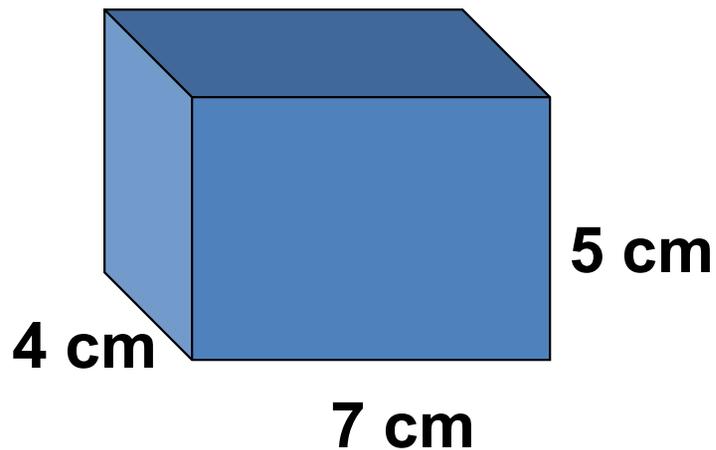
$$V = 140\text{cm}^3$$

- Does it matter which side is the base?

$$V = B \times h$$

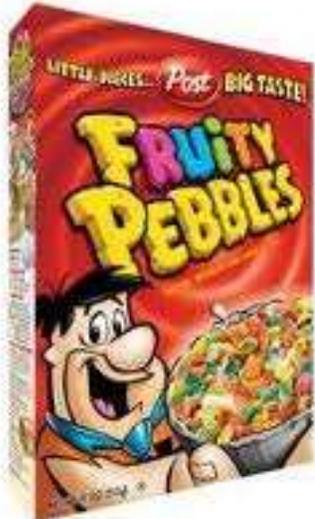
$$V = l \times w \times h$$



$$V = 7\text{cm} \times 4\text{cm} \times 5\text{cm}$$

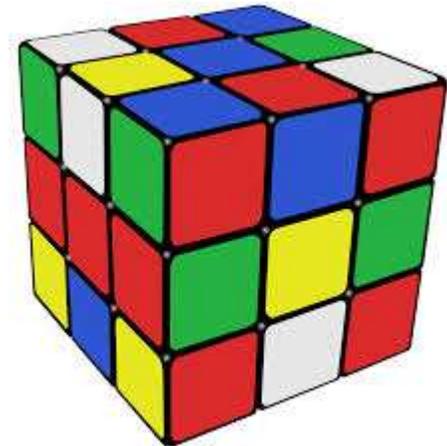
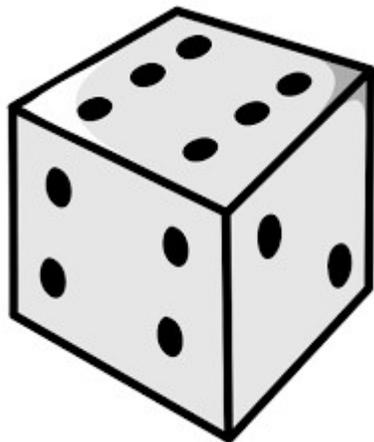
RECTANGULAR PRISM

- A **RECTANGULAR PRISM**, is a solid figure that has **six** faces that are all **rectangles**. Opposite faces are **congruent** and **parallel**.

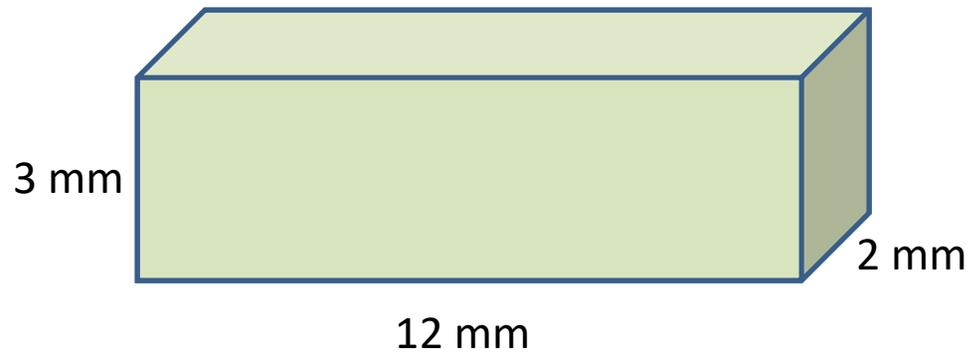


Cube

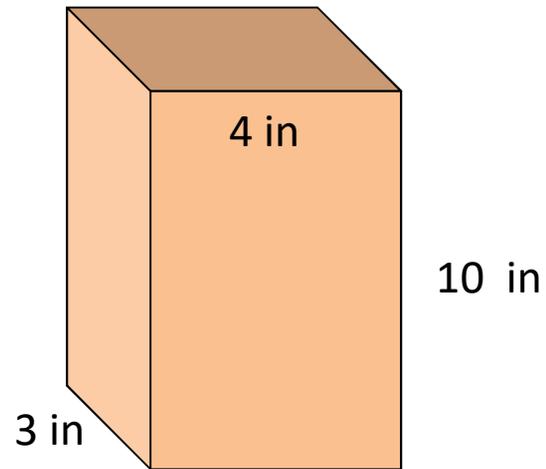
- **A CUBE**, is a solid figure that has **six** faces that are all **squares**. All faces are congruent and parallel. This shape is classified as a rectangular prism because all squares are technically **rectangles**



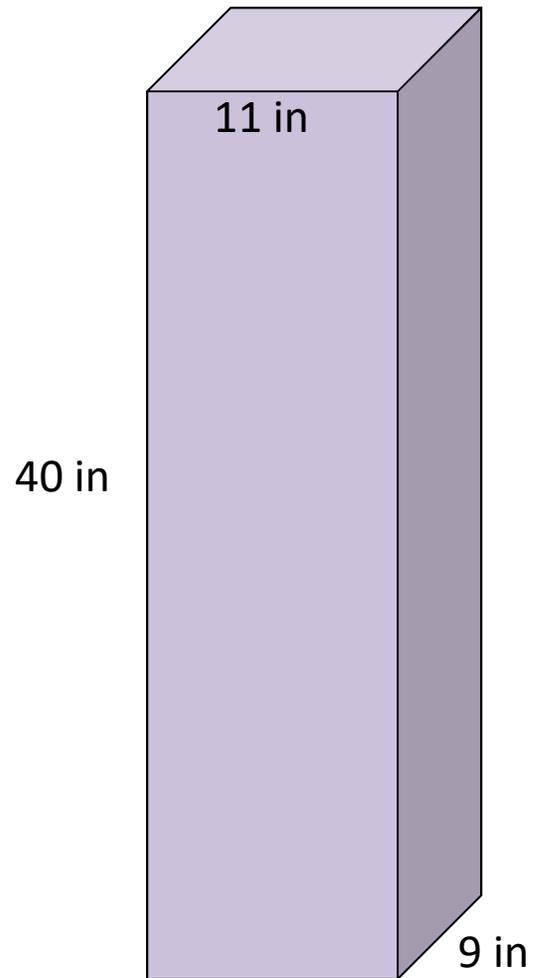

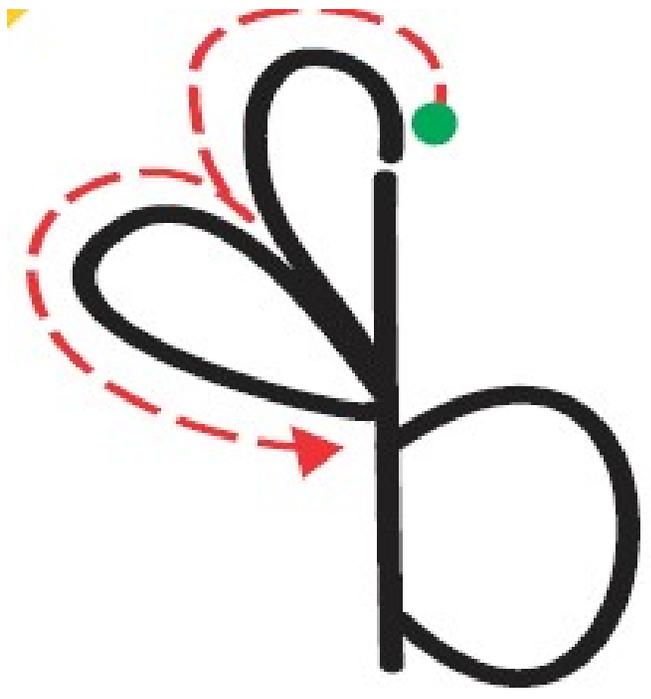


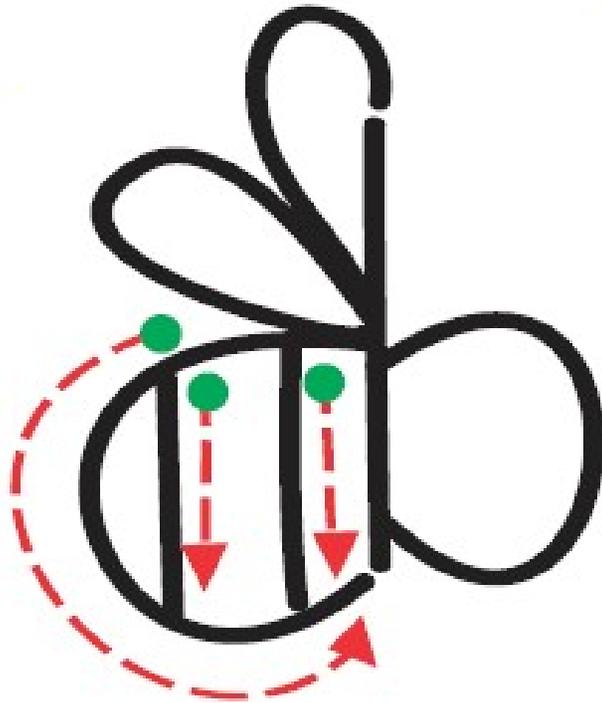
A cereal box has a length of 8 inches, a width of 1.75 inches, and a height of 12.125 inches? How much cereal will the box hold?

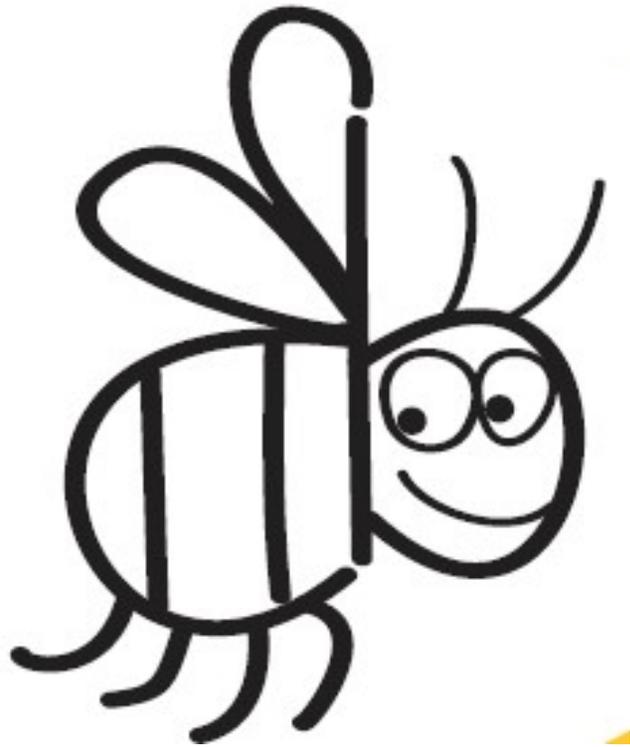
